WHO CAN VOTE

You are a US citizen, **AND** you are 18+ years old on Election Day, **AND** you have lived at your NC address for 30 days before Election Day, **AND** you are not currently serving a felony sentence, including probation or parole.

16- AND 17-YEAR-OLDS CAN PRE-REGISTER TO VOTE

WHAT TO BRING

Unexpired or expired for one year or less

- NC Driver License or DMV issued ID
- US passport or passport card
- NC Student ID* or NC Government ID*
- FREE ID from county board of elections
- Out-of-state driver license only if voter registers within 90 days of the election

Regardless of expiration

- US military or Veteran ID
- Tribal ID
- ID card from US or NC government public assistance program
